The Supervisor will be competent on working in Telecoms Networks and have experience of working on City Fibre installations.

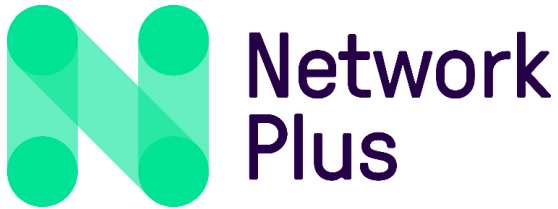

City Fibre has a significant investment programme underway to develop a gigabit-capable full fibre network that will allow it to connect eight million homes and businesses across the UK by 2025.

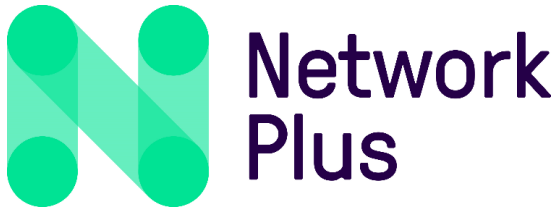
The Bradford works cover the construction of the FTTP network for approximately 137,300 premises and associated feeder network construction.

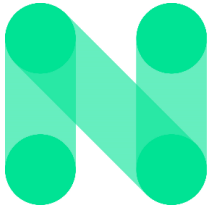
